

Washington Stars Quilt Donations

Washington Stars have been generous on making quilts for donations. Here is a list of possible donations sites with sizes each group needs. If you make a quilt for a certain place, please pin a note on the quilt when you donate it.

The charity committee is open to other suggestions in addition to the list below. By using the size requested by each group, it avoids having quilts that don't fit the needs of an organization. The committee has batting and material available for you to use.

1. Fisher House is like a Ronald McDonald House at Madigan. Request quilts of any size.
2. American Hero quilts are for wounded veterans confined to wheelchairs. They are at Madigan. They request patriotic appearing quilts 54" X 67".
3. Public Affairs of Madigan Hospital request lap size quilts (50" X 60") for wounded military in the hospital. They prefer flannel on one side.
4. Children Service Office of WN State would like quilts to give to kids in foster care. They have infants to 19 year olds. Quilts go to kids in group care, own home, gifts for birthday, Christmas, and traumatic events (coming into foster care). These are for our local area. Quilt size varies according to age groups - baby quilts, children quilts to twin size.
5. Bags of Love donate quilts to children who must be removed from their home. They include a quilt with a soft toy and personal care items. They want quilts made with thick batting, size 48" X 60". They can be tied.
6. Providence Maternal Child Health of Olympia visits homes and would like baby and children quilts of any size.
7. Care Net pregnancy of Olympia helps pregnant women in need. They want crib size baby quilts 31" X 51".
8. Baby Bank of Olympia operates like the Food Bank, giving quilts to parents who come to get baby supplies.
9. Hospice (Olympia) needs lap size quilts. 54" X 67".

We are donating 13 quilts to Habitat for Humanity to be given to new homeowners when they dedicate their new homes in July. We have also donated 8 twin-size quilts to Safeplace, and 10 lap quilts to Public Affairs at Madigan Hospital for wounded military.
